Our Expectations of You

1. In both your verbal testimony and lifestyle, be in agreement with Glad Tidings' mission statement.

3. Staff members are not allowed to go to a secluded place with only one camper, regardless of the camper's gender. Unmarried staff members of the opposite sex are not to be alone together in a secluded place.

We are grateful for your interest in serving with us this summer. Our intent is to equip you and minister to you even as you serve the Lord here by serving people.
