

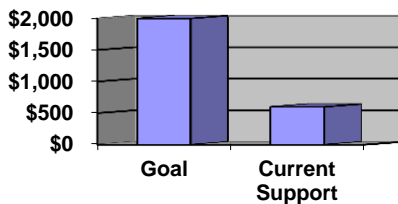

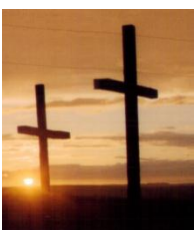


GTBC, Inc. Annual Business Meeting:
